Job Title: Director of Development

About the School: Imago Dei Neighborhood School is a young, purpose-built, ethnically and economically diverse Christian liberal arts school in Richmond, Virginia. The school serves 120 students in PreK - 6th grade (Fall 2024). As a school seeking to serve families who might not otherwise have this opportunity, generous philanthropy is mission-critical.

Position Overview: Imago Dei Neighborhood School is seeking a dynamic and experienced professional to serve as the school's first Director of Development. *In partnership with the Executive Director*, the Director of Development will play a pivotal role in advancing the school's mission by leading fundraising efforts, cultivating donor relationships, and implementing strategic initiatives to support the school's continued growth and sustainability.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. **Fundraising Strategy**: Develop and execute comprehensive fundraising strategies aligned with the school's mission and vision.
- 2. **Donor Cultivation**: Cultivate and steward relationships with current and prospective donors, including individuals, corporations, foundations, and community partners.
- 3. **Major Gifts Program**: Develop and implement strategies to identify, solicit, and steward major donors capable of making significant contributions to the school.
- 4. **Grant Writing and Management**: Identify grant opportunities, prepare grant proposals, and manage the grant application process from submission to reporting.
- 5. **Annual Fund Campaigns**: Plan and oversee annual fund campaigns, including online giving and fundraising events.
- 6. **Collaboration and Communication**: Collaborate closely with school leadership, board members, faculty, and staff to align development efforts with organizational goals. Communicate effectively with stakeholders to convey the impact of philanthropic support.
- 7. **Database Management**: Oversee donor database management, ensuring accurate and up-to-date records of donor interactions, gifts, and pledges.
- 8. **Compliance and Reporting**: Ensure compliance with relevant laws and regulations governing charitable fundraising activities. Prepare regular reports on fundraising progress and outcomes for internal and external stakeholders.

- Bachelor's degree.
- Minimum of 3 years of experience in nonprofit fundraising, with a track record of success in donor cultivation, grant writing, and major gifts solicitation.
- Strong commitment to the mission and values of Imago Dei Neighborhood School.

- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal, with the ability to articulate the school's vision and impact to diverse audiences.
- Demonstrated ability to think strategically, set goals, and execute plans to achieve desired outcomes.
- Proficiency in fundraising software and donor database management preferred.
- Understanding of and respect for Christian principles and the diverse cultural and religious backgrounds of the school community.
- Entrepreneurial spirit; eager to build a sustainable, emotionally intelligent, best-practice development operation that reflects the ethos and mission of the school.
